**The MathOnline program at The University of Colorado at Colorado Springs (UCCS)** is currently in its **20th** year of delivering standard, traditional university mathematics courses **via the Internet** to students throughout the country. Students can fully participate in these courses without leaving the comfort and convenience of their location and earn college credits in the process. These credit hours can be (and have been) transferred to institutions of higher learning throughout the country and beyond.

We believe that the power and distinguishing feature of our online courses lie in the fact that students enrolled therein get the **REAL DEAL**. Courses delivered via MathOnline are *not* just a series of web pages which students are expected to access as the spirit so moves them. Rather, the courses are identical in every respect to the high quality, traditional courses we deliver to our students on the UCCS campus. Indeed, the MathOnline program has garnered some significant national attention, with articles about it appearing in both *Focus Magazine* (the magazine of the Mathematical Association of America) and in the online journal *The Technology Source*.

Starting with the Fall 2015 semester we have implemented new technologies for lecture capturing via the Mediasite Platform, to improve the students experience in the course.
